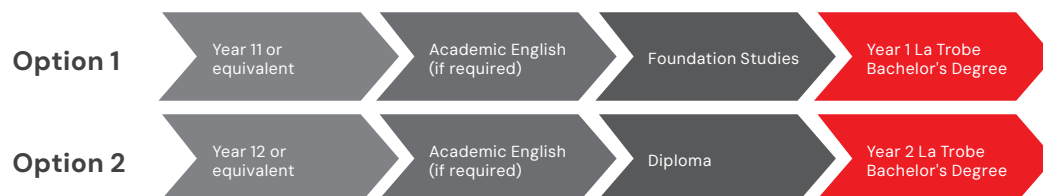

To receive a package offer for Foundation Studies or Diploma of Health Sciences leading to the Bachelor of Nursing, Bachelor of Physiotherapy (Honours) or Bachelor of Occupational Therapy (Honours), an IELTS score of minimum 6.5 overall (no band less than 6.5) is required. At the time of progressing to the bachelor's degree students will need an IELTS score of minimum 7.0 overall (no band less than 7.0).
