# Student Support



## Student learning advisor

As a LTCA student, you'll have access to a dedicated Student Learning Advisor who can assist you in developing the skills to tackle a wide range of academic issues, including time management, research and referencing skills, exam preparation, and more. You can work together with the Student Learning Advisor to develop an individual support system based on evidence-based research that will help boost your academic performance.

You can book a 45-minute individual or group appointment with the Student Learning Advisor either on campus or online for help in the following key areas:

- time management and organisation
- study skills
- research skills and using the library
- paraphrasing, summarising, and quoting
- referencing
- getting started on assessments
- exam preparation
- guidance on academic integrity, collusion, and contract cheating.

## PAL (Peer assisted learning) mentors

If you're looking for some extra help, you can meet one-on-one with a PAL Mentor for some extra study support. Our PAL Mentors are Diploma graduates, so they understand the challenges from lived experience and are familiar with the assessment tasks you'll be facing. All of our PAL Mentors are currently in the 2nd or 3rd year of their La Trobe University bachelor's degrees and have been trained to help you succeed in your studies.

PAL Mentors can help you by:

- being approachable, supportive, and encouraging and by always treating discussions as confidential
- guiding you towards a better understanding of an assignment's requirements
- offering learning support to help you succeed in your units
- helping you get organized and assisting you in developing effective study habits
- providing information on other support services available at La Trobe College Australia and La Trobe University
- assisting you with unit-related questions through face-to-face meetings or online meetings via Zoom
- PAL Mentors do not:
  - proof-read or edit work for students, nor re-teach content of classes/tutorials
- assist students with the content of assignments, as this would be collusion

# ATAR, Change of Preference & Accepting your offer



## Australian Tertiary Admission Rank (ATAR)

VIC students will receive their ATAR on Monday, December 12th 2022.. After you find out your ATAR, use this time to talk to us about the pathways you planned earlier in the year.

## Pathway options

Now you know your ATAR you can make sure your preference list includes all your pathway options. Make sure you:

- leave your dream course as your number one preference
- attend one of our consultation sessions to speak to us about your options
- include multiple pathways in your preference list just in case
- research what will be required for you to move in to your dream course later.

## Change of preference

After your ATAR is released you will have the opportunity to log into UAC and change your list of course preferences. During this time you can add, delete or re-order your preferences. This is your chance to make sure your dream course is at the top while also including some pathway options in your list. The change of preference period for the December 21st VTAC offer round begins on August 1st and ends on December 14th.
