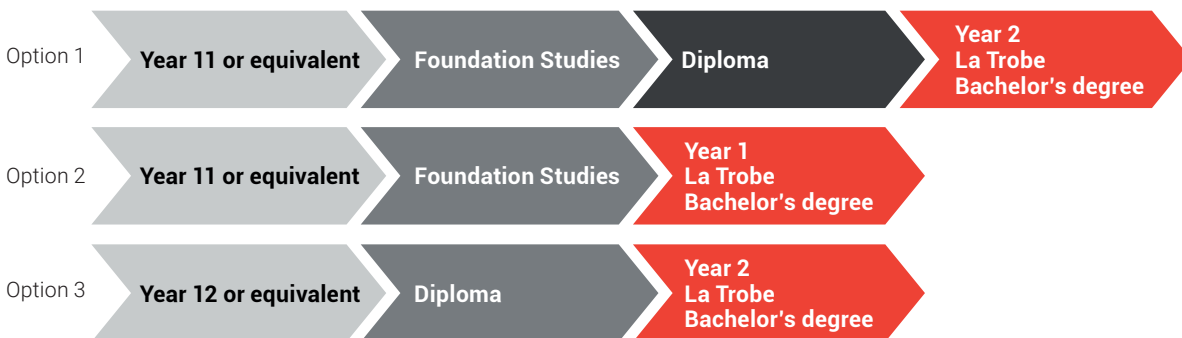

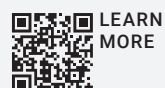

## LA TROBE INTERNATIONAL SCHOLARSHIPS

The scholarships offer a fee reduction of 15, 20 or 25 per cent on annual tuition fees for the duration of your studies and are limited in number.

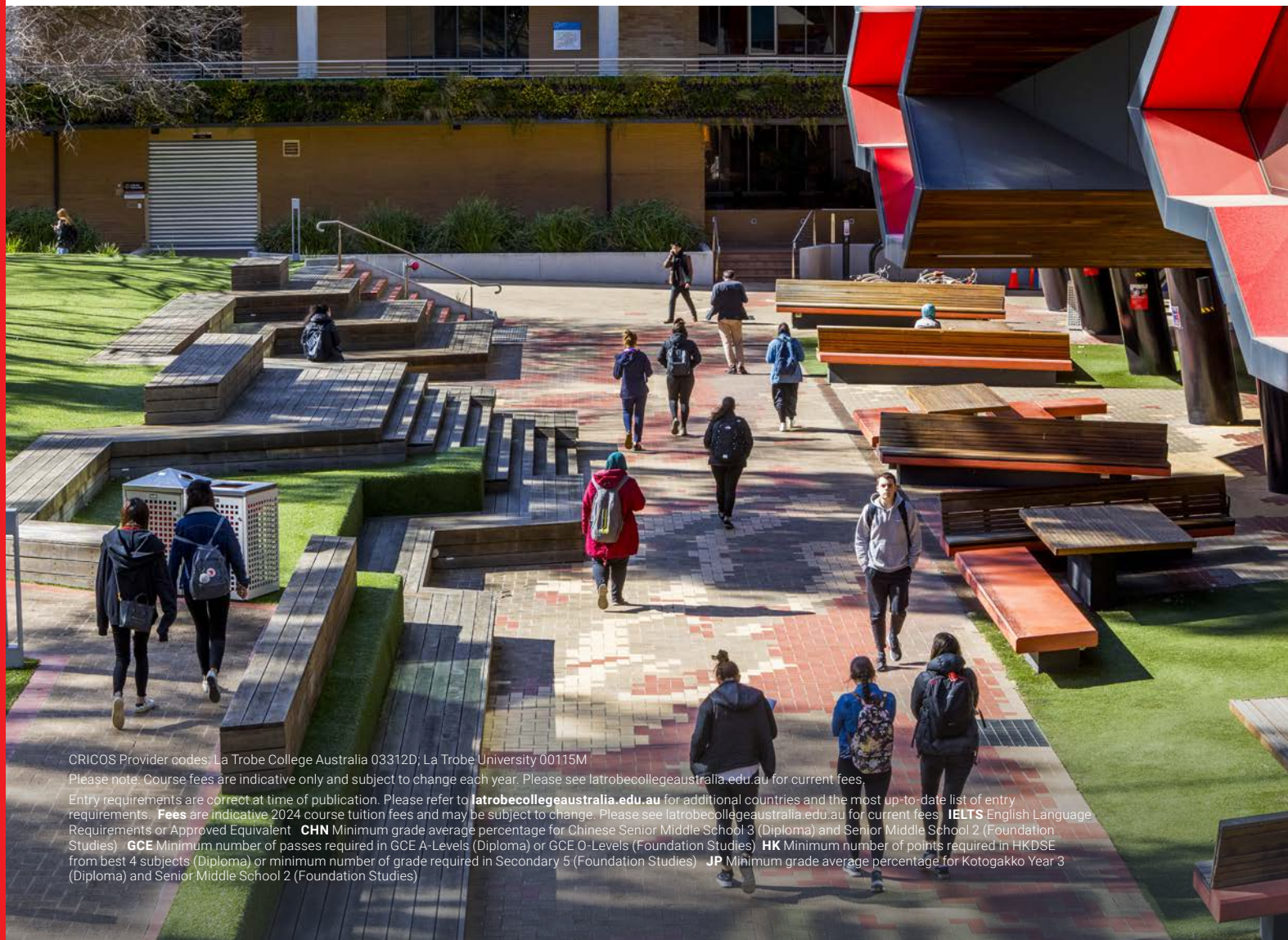
